

Overview

The DOLFIN protocol states that "Primary outcome (PARCA-R) and secondary outcome neurodevelopmental data will be shared with the local neonatologist or paediatrician, or GP for participants no longer under hospital follow-up; information about norms will be provided to aid local clinician interpretation."

All parents whose infants are enrolled in DOLFIN consented to this at initial recruitment.

These data refer to:

- The Parent Report of Children's Abilities-Revised (PARCA-R)
- The Ages and Stages Questionnaire-3 (ASQ-3) (more information at https://agesandstages.com/productspricing/asq3)
- The Strengths and Difficulties Questionnaire (SDQ) (more information at <u>https://www.sdqinfo.org/py/sdqinfo/c0.py</u>)

We hope that sharing this information will be clinically useful at sites and may prevent parents needing to complete one or more measures again. It is the PI's responsibility to ensure that this information, provided by parents in the 24-month follow-up questionnaire, reaches the clinician responsible for the infant's ongoing care.

Method

When a parent completes their infant's 24-month follow-up questionnaire, the site staff will receive an email flagging this. This email will have a guide to scoring the PARCA-R questionnaire attached. This is for information only; no scoring at site is required unless you personally plan to use the results in your service. It will also include the links to the ASQ-3 and SDQ given above.

When you receive this email, go to the infant's Participant Details page on OpenClinica.



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Remember:

- Make sure that the **Parent 24 Month Questionnaire** is completed (the check mark icon on the form is green). Do not carry out this process if the icon is orange (2)
- The **Parent-provided 24-month data** CRF should already be scheduled (shown with the **S** icon)
- If the **Parent-provided 24-month data** CRF is not scheduled / visible, return to the infant's record the next day (there may be a delay in syncing between our systems). If it is still not visible, contact the DOLFIN Coordinating Centre
- Do **NOT** download the **Parent 24 Month Questionnaire** itself. The questionnaire contains several sections and the parent did not give consent for all of these to be shared

Click on the Parent-provided 24-month data CRF tile:



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This will open the CRF:

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Click on the Print icon in the top-right corner:





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Once you have downloaded the PDF:

- Save a copy to the infant's medical notes
- Securely send a copy to the clinician responsible for the infant's ongoing care (or their GP if they are no longer under specialist review) along with the guide to scoring the PARCA-R and the links to further information on the ASQ-3 and SDQ

Once you have completed this process, the CRF will show as Data Entry Started on the infant's Participant Details page:
